Overview cont'd

Modular training

- **Module I** deals with the basics of Gender concepts, defining common terminologies, types of violence, its magnitude and consequences. It also touches upon the multi-sectoral response including the legal context of GBV in health
- **Module II** addresses the clinical response and management to GBV/Sexual violence. It includes vastly the clinical assessment, clinical management/treatment, Survivors' clinical follow-up and level of service provision along the health service network model.
- **Module III** covers the provision of psychological treatment and support. Counseling support for survivors, types and level of psychological support and social interventions as well as referral for rehabilitation and social re-integration
- **Module IV** deals with prevention of GBV with focus on sexual violence. Community mobilization and public awareness; promotion of health education in health facilities; identification and promotion of health seeking behavior in the community
- **Module V** introduces the Monitoring and Evaluation of GBV and data registration tools, reporting (internal and legal), and referral formats. Report to the National health management information system (HMIS) and analysis and organization of data on GBV
